Third Thursdays at 6:30 pm

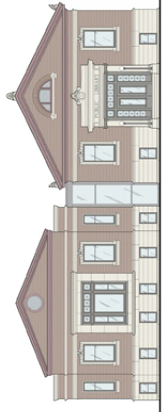
